Report to the Investors

Equititrust Limited (Receiver Appointed) (In Liquidation) (Receivers and Managers Appointed) A.C.N. 061 383 944 ("the Company")

I refer to my previous reports and provide an update on the Liquidation of the Company.

Investigations and Litigation

- Public Examinations were scheduled to be conducted on a number of individuals on 23-26 July 2013 however will be adjourned to a later date, yet to be fixed;
- The Liquidators have now reached agreement with the Company's previous auditor in relation to the production of certain records which is expected to occur on 23 July 2013.

Litigation Funding Deed

- I have recommenced my negotiations with Piper Alderman in relation to progressing the draft litigation funding deed;
- The Liquidators amendments to the draft funding deed proposed by Piper Alderman have been provided to them for their comments and review;
- Once a Deed is in an acceptable form, it will be put to the Creditors or the Committee of Inspection or the Court for approval.

Asset and Liability Position

The only remaining asset to be realised by the Company (in its own right) is the
debt owed pursuant to a Deed of Settlement between ETL, Waragal Pty Limited,
Rosea Pty Limited ("Rosea"), James Raptis and Crystal Point Pty Limited ("Deed
of Settlement") in the amount of \$783,916.

I was advised on 7 June 2013 by the legal representatives of the Court appointed Receiver to the Equititrust Income Fund ("EIF") that the final payment pursuant to the Deed of Settlement would not be paid on 14 June 2013 as expected. Instead, I was advised that an alternate proposal would be provided for the repayment of the debt.

I am advised that a proposal has been submitted to the solicitors for the Court appointed Receiver, however despite requests that a copy be provided to this office, we are yet to receive a copy.

I have recently engaged in an exchange of correspondence with the legal representatives acting for the National Australia Bank Limited ("NAB") in relation to their secured position, the debt owing to them and a proposal for a transfer of the remaining Bank Guarantees. I will provide further updates once they become available.

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Liquidators Remuneration

• I refer to the comments in my previous report in relation to my remuneration application and advise that I am still awaiting the outcome of this application;
